The **seminar** presents two research projects in the city of Durban using participatory methods, including oral histories and narrative performances, to make sense of women's experiences of migration, inclusion/exclusion, and living in a prison.

The **workshop** explores how interdisciplinary projects in the fields of sociology and drama and performance studies make use of narrative and applied theatre methodologies to engage with issues of social difference, identity and discrimination.
